Round up your friends and horses! Ride English or Western. This will be a pleasant ride, at your own pace, through scenic Metamora horse country in teams of 2 - 4 riders. No jumping is required. If you do not have a team, we will make one for you.

Teams opting to compete for the fastest time depart between 8:00 am and 8:30 am. 1st through 6th place ribbons will be awarded to the teams with the fastest times.

Teams riding at their own pace depart between 8:30 am to 12:30 pm. 1st through 6th place ribbons will be awarded to the teams closest to optimum time (this is intended to simulate the pace of a real foxhunt).

Registration: the 2022 Summer Hunter Pace Entry Form and the Metamora Hunt Release and Hold Harmless Agreement are available at www.metamorahunt.com on FORMS/RESOURCES, or the forms can be obtained at the event. Each rider must sign a Release and Hold Harmless Agreement. Bring filled out and signed forms and entry fees with you to the event.
